EASTER TRIDUUM

The Easter Triduum begins on the evening of Holy Thursday and ends on the evening of Easter Sunday. The word "Triduum" comes from two Latin words which mean "three days".

The Triduum is liturgically one celebration. Therefore the Easter Triduum begins at sundown on Holy Thursday with the Mass of the Lord's Supper, continues with the celebration of the Lord's Passion on Good Friday and concludes with the day of the Lord's Resurrection, which includes the Easter Vigil.

During the Triduum we celebrate the essential mystery of the Christian faith: Jesus' triumph over death and our own participation in the resurrection. We come together in a special way to remember the saving act of Jesus and the miracle of His Resurrection, and we celebrate our faith and identity as Christians.

SAFEGUARDING

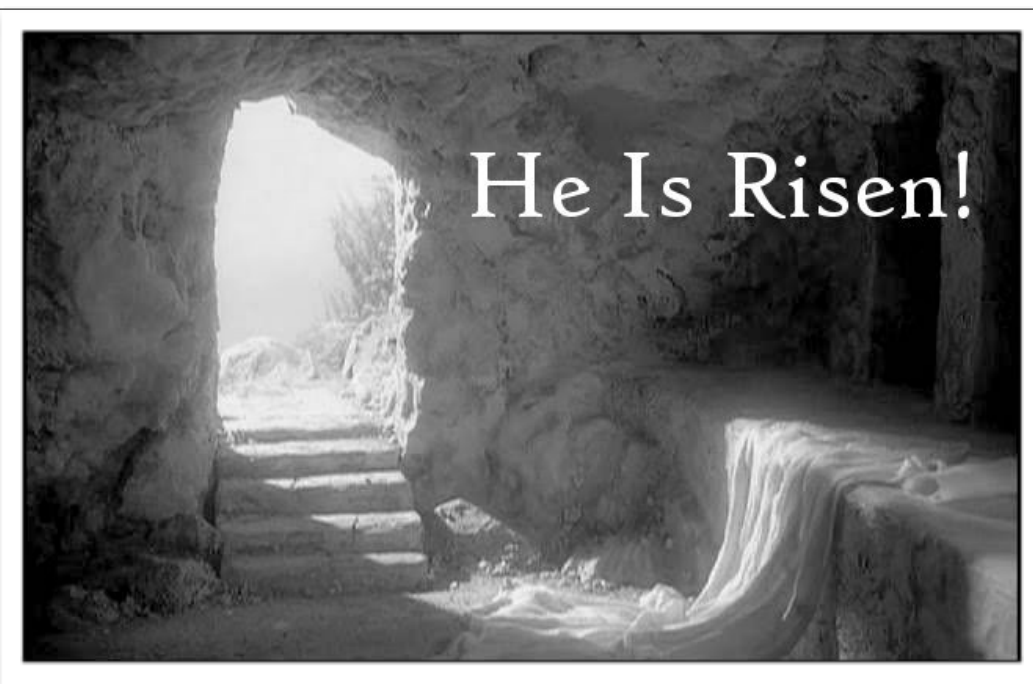
