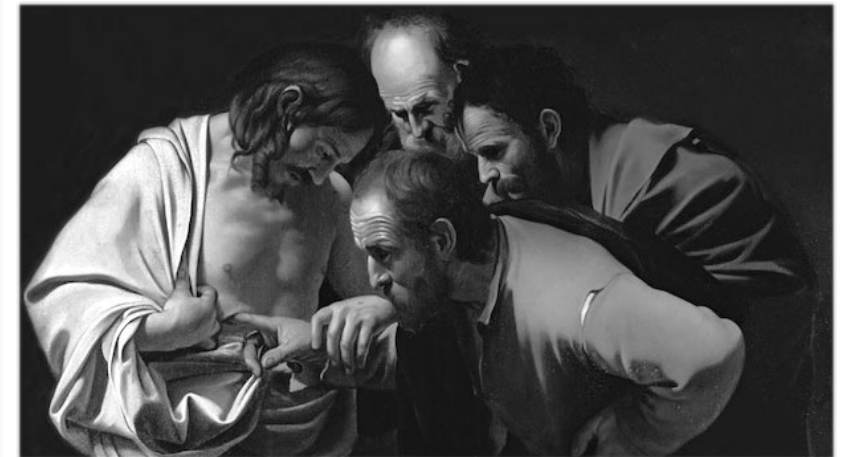

The instituted ministries of acolyte and lector were introduced in the reforms after Vatican

II as a development, replacing the former minor orders. The discipline of the Church is that men are admitted to these ministries whilst preparing for Ordination.
