LITURGY FOR CHILDREN

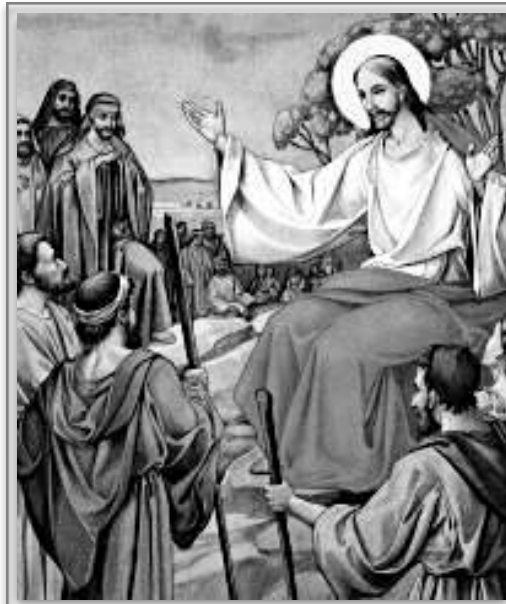
